

1. Preamble

Cyberint Technologies Ltd. (hereinafter: “Cyberint” or “Our” or “We” or “Us”), are committed to protect your personal information. To ensure transparency and give you more control over your personal information. This Data Protection Policy explains how Cyberint collects, processes and stores the information from you or other data subjects in the course of our business activities through Cyberint websites (the “Services”).

As used in this policy, “**Personal Information**” means information that refers to, is related to, or is associated with an identified or identifiable individual or as otherwise may be defined by applicable law, such as a name, address, telephone number, e-mail address, information about activities directly linked to a person, such as that person’s location or IP information.

Cyberint is registered in Israel with its head office located at Ha-Mefalsim 17 St Petah Tikva, Israel. For any questions regarding the collection, processing or use of personal information relating to you (as explained below) please contact our Data Protection Officer, at: legal@cyberint.com.

2. General Principles of Our Data Protection

This Policy explains your rights regarding the personal information Cyberint collects, processes and uses, including via its websites, as well as Cyberint’s use of safeguards to protect these rights, and further applies also to Cyberint’s use of cookies and tracking tools, as specified in detail in our Cookies and Tracking Policy.

Important note: please refrain from logging in and making use of our website, or otherwise providing Us with your personal information, if you do not agree to the collection, use, processing or disclosure of this data as set forth herein.

3. Your Rights to Limit our Collection and Processing

You have certain rights in relation to the Personal Information that we hold about you, as detailed below:

- You have the right to withdraw consent to the processing, where consent is the basis of processing.
- You have the right to access the personal information that we hold and request further details about how we process it, under certain conditions.
- You have the right to demand rectification of inaccurate personal information about you. We will promptly correct any information found to be incorrect.
- You have the right to object to unlawful data processing under certain conditions.
- You have the right to the erasure of past data about you (your “right to be forgotten”) under certain conditions.
- You have the right to demand that we restrict the processing of your personal information, under certain conditions, if you believe we have exceeded the legitimate basis for processing, the processing is no longer necessary, or if you believe your personal information is inaccurate.
- You have the right to data portability of personal information concerning you that you provided us in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format, subject to certain conditions.
- The personal information we collect is not used for automated decision-making and profiling, except for automated processes in the context of marketing. As stated above, you can opt out of direct marketing by Cyberint by contacting Cyberint directly or by following the instructions through the unsubscribe options in our email messages.

You can exercise your rights by contacting us at legal@cyberint.com. You may use an authorized agent to submit a request on your behalf if you provide the authorized agent with written permission signed by you. To protect your privacy, we may take steps to verify your identity before fulfilling your request. Subject to legal and other permissible considerations, we will make every reasonable effort to honor your request promptly in accordance with applicable law or inform you if we require further information in order to fulfil your request. When processing your request, we may ask you for additional information to confirm or verify your identity and for security purposes, before processing and/or honoring your request. We reserve the right to charge a fee where permitted by law, for instance if your request is manifestly unfounded or excessive. In the event that your request would adversely affect the rights and freedoms of others (for example, would impact the duty of confidentiality we owe to others) or if we are legally entitled to deal with your request in a different way than initially requested, we will address your request to the maximum extent possible, all in accordance with applicable law.

4. Information We Collect:

The personal Information collected and used by Cyberint is limited strictly to that data necessary for us to provide you with services you request in the course of our ongoing business while operating under our relevant legal and data protection legislation and regulations obligations.

4.1. What and when is the Personal Information collected:

- a. **Information provided through the Services.** We collect personal information that you voluntarily provide. We also collect the contact and billing information of our customers.
- b. **Information provided through the Website.** When you use the website, we collect and process full name, email address, phone number, comments and messages, and any other information that you decide to provide us with when you interact with the website.
- c. **Information automatically collected.** We automatically collect certain information through your use of Cyberint’s website, such as cookie, pixels, tracking technologies and similar identifiers (“Technologies”), your Internet protocol (IP) address, and other device identifiers that are automatically assigned to your device, browser type and language, geo-location information, hardware type, operating system, internet service provider and other information about actions taken through the use of the website.
- d. **Information to assess candidates.** When you provide us via the website, email or other means, or we acquire from recruiting agencies, your personal information to assess you as a candidate you provide your CV, cover letter, contact details, and portfolio.
- e. **Information from Other Sources.** Cyberint also obtain information about you from other sources, including publicly - or commercially- available information, and through third-party data platforms, partners and service providers. In addition, in certain cases, Cyberint may collect information from publicly available sources to provide the services to our customers (e.g., to check whether there is any breach, incident, security concern with respect to the customers’ (and/or customer’s end users) assets).
- f. **Information you provide to us in person.** For example, when you visit one of our exhibition booths or attend one of our events and you provide us with your contact details. We will use this information to answer your enquiries or provide additional information to you.
- g. **Information we collect from online interactions.** For example, if you attend a webinar, contact us via social media or otherwise interact with our business, including as a representative of a current / prospective customer, supplier or partner, we track and make a record of those interactions, which may contain your contact details, such as full name, email address, messages and any other information that you decide to provide us with.

5. Why Cyberint Uses your Personal Information:

Cyberint uses data and personal information for the following reasons:

- a. **To provide you with the Services.** We will use the information, including, without limitation, for the following purposes: (i) allow you to create an account; (ii) to provide you the Services and to process your requests; (iii) communicate with you about your use of the Services and for support purposes; (iv) fulfill any instruction and/or request made by you in the context of the Services; (v) send you push notifications and/or emails and notifications regarding your account or certain features of the Services, including, updates pertaining to your subscription, and related to the services we provide you with; (vi) to personalize your experience with our Services; (vii) to allow you to create more users and administrate your users; (viii) to generally administer and improve the Services.
- b. **To allow you to make use of our Website.** We will use your information to allow you to make use of our website, including, (i) to answer your request, for example: if you request a demo, we will use your Personal Information to process and answer your request for a demo; (ii) to answer your questions and to allow you to communicate with us; (iii) to analyze your use of our website and to improve our website; and (iv) to customize your experience, including to make sure that content in the website is presented in the most effective manner for you, including personalization .
- c. **For Administrative Purposes.** Cyberint use your information (i) to respond to your questions, comments, and other requests for customer support, or information, including information about potential or future services; (ii) to provide you with our Services; (iii) for internal quality control purposes; (iv) to establish a business relationship; (v) to generally administer our Services;
- d. **To Market our Website and Services.** Cyberint uses information to market Cyberint’s Services. Such use includes (i) notifying you about offers and services that may be of interest to you; (ii) tailoring content, advertisements, and offers for you, including, targeting and re-targeting practices; (iii) conducting market research; (iv) developing and marketing new products and services, and to measure interest in our services; (v) other purposes disclosed at the time you provide information; (vi) as you otherwise consent;
- e. **Security purposes.** Some of the abovementioned information will be used for detecting, taking steps to prevent and prosecuting fraud or other illegal activity; to identify and repair errors; to conduct audits; and for security purposes. Information may also be used to comply with applicable laws, with investigations performed by the relevant authorities, law enforcement purposes, and/or to exercise or defend legal claims.
- f. **De-identified and Aggregated Information Use.** In certain cases, we may or will anonymize or de-identify your Information and further use it for internal and external purposes, including, without limitation, to analyze and improve Cyberint’s services (including through the use of artificial intelligence) and for research purposes. We will use this anonymous or de-identified information and/or disclose it to third parties without restrictions (for example, in order to improve our services and enhance your experience with them, for commercial and non-commercial purposes, and/or to develop new product features and improve existing offerings).
- g. **Cookies and Similar Technologies.** We, as well as third parties that provide content, advertising, or other functionality on the Website and Services, use Technologies to automatically collect information through the Website and Services. We use Technologies that are essentially small data files placed on your device that allow us to record certain pieces of information whenever you visit or interact with the Website and Services. We process the information for performance of analytics such as trend analysis, site administration, statistical analysis of usage of the site, enhance and review integrity and stability of the website.

6. **The lawful bases we rely on for processing personal information are (if and when applicable):**

- You have given consent to the processing of your Personal Information;
- Processing is necessary for the performance of a contract to which you are party or in order to take steps at the request of the data subject prior to entering into a contract;
- Processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which the controller is subject;
- Processing is necessary for the purposes of the legitimate interest.

7. **Automated decision-making.** Cyberint shall not intentionally take any potentially damaging decision concerning you because of using automated processing operations without human intervention; and commits to giving you the opportunity to obtain human intervention in such a decision, express your point of view, and obtain an explanation of the decision by contacting our Data Protection Officer, at E-mail legal@cyberint.com. Note that your request may also be rejected by Cyberint for lack of relevant information provided by you. In the implementation of these data protection rights, Cyberint is committed to providing a timely and transparent response to your requests, and upholding your right to contact Cyberint's Data Protection Officer directly. 8. **How We Protect Information:**

We implement generally accepted industry standards to maintain the safety of your Personal Information against loss, alteration, theft or access by unauthorized third parties when you enter, submit, or access your Personal Information and once we receive it. However, no method of transmission over the Internet, or method of electronic storage is 100% secure. Therefore, while we strive to use commercially acceptable means to protect your personal information, we cannot guarantee its absolute security.

9. **Third Party Sites:**

Our website may contain links to third party websites. We have no control over third-party sites or services, and all use of third-party sites or services is at your own risk. Cyberint cannot accept responsibility for the privacy policies of any such third-party sites and such third-party websites are governed solely by such third parties' privacy policies and you are advised to be careful and check any such third party's privacy policies and compliance with laws, prior to supplying them with any of your Personal Information to them. Cyberint is not responsible for content available by means of such third party sites. Cyberint does not endorse any products offered by third parties and we urge our users to exercise caution in using third-party services.

10. **Data Retention and Deletion**

Cyberint deletes Personal Information where the business purpose for which the data was being collected or processed ceases to apply, or if applicable data protection rules require us to delete such personal data

However, we shall keep your Personal Information only as long as necessary to provide you with the Cyberint Service and for legitimate and essential business purposes, such as maintaining the performance of the Cyberint Service, making data-driven business decisions about new features and offerings, complying with our legal obligations, and resolving disputes, such as the following circumstances:

- If there is an unresolved issue relating to your account, such as an outstanding credit on your account or an unresolved claim or dispute we will retain the necessary personal data until the issue is resolved;
- Where we are required to retain the personal data for our legal, tax, audit, and accounting obligations, we will retain the necessary personal data for the period required by applicable law; and/or,

Where necessary for our legitimate business interests such as fraud prevention or to maintain the security of our users. The above notwithstanding, there are types of personal information that we will only keep for as long as you are a user of the Cyberint Service, such as your e-mail address and other information sent as part of the newsletter subscription process, and we will delete them upon your expressed request to our Data Protection Officer, as mentioned above.

11. **How We Share Your Personal Information**

In addition to the recipients described above, we may share your Personal Information as follows:

- 11.1. With our affiliated companies.
- 11.2. With CRM providers or other similar tool providers.
- 11.3. To the extent necessary, with regulators, courts or competent authorities, to comply with applicable laws, regulations and rules (including, without limitation, federal, state or local laws), and requests of law enforcement, regulatory and other governmental agencies or if required to do so by court order;
- 11.4. If, in the future, we sell or transfer, or we consider selling or transferring, some or all of our business, shares or assets to a third party, we will disclose your Personal Information to such third party (whether actual or potential) in connection with the foregoing events;
- 11.5. In the event that we are acquired by, or merged with, a third party entity, or in the event of bankruptcy or a comparable event, we reserve the right to transfer, disclose or assign your Personal Information in connection with the foregoing events, including, in connection with, or during negotiations of, any merger, sale of company assets, consolidation or restructuring, financing, or acquisition of all or a portion of our business by or to another company; and/or
- 11.6. Where you have provided your consent to us sharing or transferring your Personal Information (e.g., where you provide us with marketing consents or opt-in to optional additional services or functionality).

12. **Transfer of Your Information:**

- 12.1. External transfers: We transfer Personal Information to third parties who assist us in operating our services, conducting our business, or servicing you, so long as those parties agree to keep this information confidential and to not use it for any purpose other than to fulfill their obligations to us. We share you information with subcontractors and other partners that are located in countries which could be outside of your jurisdiction. All our subcontractors and other third parties will be subject to contractual obligations limiting their use of your Personal Information and subjecting their activities to the applicable data protection and privacy legislations applicable to your Personal Information. All our subcontractors will be subject to non-disclosure and non-use obligations. Nevertheless, some countries may have levels of protection of personal and other information which are not at an adequate level of protection compared with what is provided in your country of residence or business.
- 12.2. Internal transfers: Transfers within the Cyberint group will be covered by an internal processing agreement entered into by members of the Cyberint group (an intra-group data processing agreement) which contractually obliges each member to ensure that Personal Data receives an adequate and consistent level of protection wherever it is transferred to.
- 12.3. Transfers: When Cyberint engages transfers of personal information, it relies on Adequacy Decisions adopted by the European Commission based on Article 45 of the GDPR (for example, when we access Personal Information from Israel), Standard Contractual Clauses laid down by the European Commission, or any other approved transfer mechanism. Cyberint continually monitors the circumstances surrounding such transfers to ensure that these maintain, in practice, a level of protection that is essentially equivalent to the level of protection guaranteed by the GDPR.

Personal information of children and minors. We do not offer our products or services for use by children and, therefore, we do not knowingly collect or process personal information relating to children and minors under the age of 18 years, unless We are legally obliged to do so by a authorized court or governmental authority order or writ or parental consent. For the purposes of the GDPR, we do not intend to *offer information society services directly to children*. If we become aware that Personal Information was transferred to us or collected by us relating to children and minors under the age of 18 years without the informed consent of a parent or legal guardian or according to a legal obligation from a court or governmental authority, We will delete such personal information without undue delay. If the request for erasure of data relates to the personal information of a child or minor, please attach to the request adequate proof of your status as parent or guardian of the child or minor.

13. **Analytic Tools.**

- **Google Analytics.** The Website uses a tool called "Google Analytics" to collect information about use of the Website. Google Analytics collects information such as how often users visit this Website, what pages they visit when they do so, and what other websites they used prior to coming to this Website. We use the information we get from Google Analytics to maintain and improve the Website and our products. We do not combine the information collected through the use of Google Analytics with Personal Information we collect. Google's ability to use and share information collected by Google Analytics about your visits to this Website is restricted by the Google Analytics Terms of Service, available at <https://marketingplatform.google.com/about/analytics/terms/us/>, and the Google Privacy Policy, available at <http://www.google.com/policies/privacy/>. You may learn more about how Google collects and processes data specifically in connection with Google Analytics at <http://www.google.com/policies/privacy/partners/>. You may prevent your data from being used by Google Analytics by downloading and installing the Google Analytics Opt-out Browser Add-on, available at <https://tools.google.com/dlpage/gaoptout/>.

14. **Automated Collection of Personal Data.** We use different automated technologies to process data from third party sources to help us check whether there is any breach, incident, security concern with respect to the customers' (and/or customer's end users) assets. To the extent Cyberint is considered a controller and such practices are deemed to be subject to the GDPR, please note that we do not provide a specific notification to data subjects because we believe that an exception of Article 14 of the GDPR would apply. In particular, the provision of such information proves impossible or would involve a disproportionate effort. In addition to the mentioned impossibility, providing information to a potential suspect or fraudster would seriously frustrate the threat intelligence purposes. For the same reason, we cannot obtain the consent of the person in question and legitimate interest is the most appropriate legal basis (Recital 47 of the GDPR). However, we have included this paragraph in our privacy policy to inform, in a generic manner, that these practices happen.

15. **Changes to this Privacy Policy**

We may revise this Policy from time to time, and such changes shall come into effect from the moment Cyberint, therefore, we ask you to check back periodically for the latest version of this Policy. If we implement significant changes to the use of your Personal Information in a manner different from that stated at the time of collection, we will notify you by posting a notice on our Website or by other means.

What's a cookie?

A cookie is a small file sent from a website or web-based interface, which is then stored by your web browser. When you return to the website or web-based interface, the information in the cookie can be used to recognize your last session. Cookies cannot install malicious software such as viruses on your device, and they do not store any of your Personal Information or account information.

Why do we use cookies?

We use cookies to save and maintain users' settings and selected preferences during browsing sessions, for saving repeating users' preferences for future use (e.g. geographical location, currency preferences accessibility and language selections and preferences), and for statistical analysis of the performance and trends on our website or interfaces and for monitoring and identifying errors.

Where do cookies come from?

Cookies originate from two types of sources: first party and third party. The classification whether a cookie is 'first' or 'third' party refers to the internet domain that is placing the cookie.

- First-party cookies are those set by a website that is being visited by the user at the time.
- Third-party cookies are cookies that are set by a domain other than that of the site being visited by the user. If a user visits a website and another entity sets a cookie through that site this would be a third party cookie.

Opt-out: When you first visit the Websites and Personal Area, you will be given the option to accept or decline the use of cookies. You can also control the use of cookies at the individual browser level, and instructions for managing cookie usage can be found for the following browsers, at:

16. Categories of cookies we use

There are two categories of cookies which are in use on our sites:

- **Session Cookies** containing encrypted information to allow the system to uniquely identify you while you are visiting the Websites, Personal Area and Apps. Session cookies exist only during a singular online session and disappear from your computer when you close your browser or turn off your computer.
- **Persistent Cookies** used to identify the fact that you are a repeating visitor or a new visitor to the Personal Area, and to identify and maintain your preferences, such as the selected language, your selected country of origin as of your last visit, in order to present the contents of the Personal Area in a personalized way according to your past selected preferences and browsing usage in order receive certain types of content. Persistent cookies remain on your computer after you have closed your browser or turned off your computer for varying periods of time, according to the duration of each cookie. They include such information as a unique identifier for your browser. We place a high priority on the security and confidentiality of the information stored in the cookies we use, and we do not for example store any of your personal information through cookies, only automated data regarding your browsing history, IP address, your computer/mobile device, location, etc.

What kind of third party cookies do we use?
